Be on the lookout for the planting of the John Gilbert Trail and make a point to wander through the trail and enjoy the peace and quiet there.

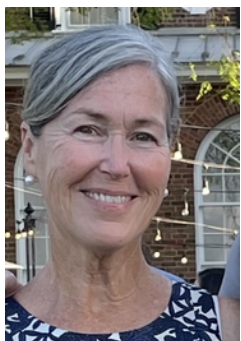
## PROGRAMS
