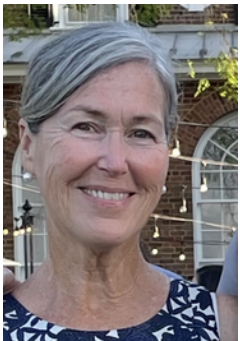
I love Deirdre's idea of flower arrangements so that needs a coordinator!

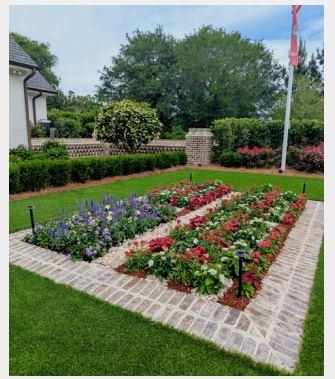

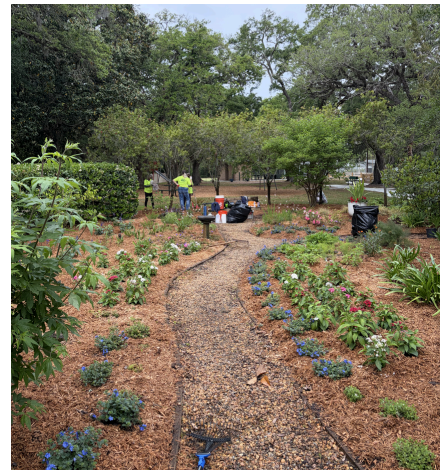


ISLAND BEAUTIFICATION
